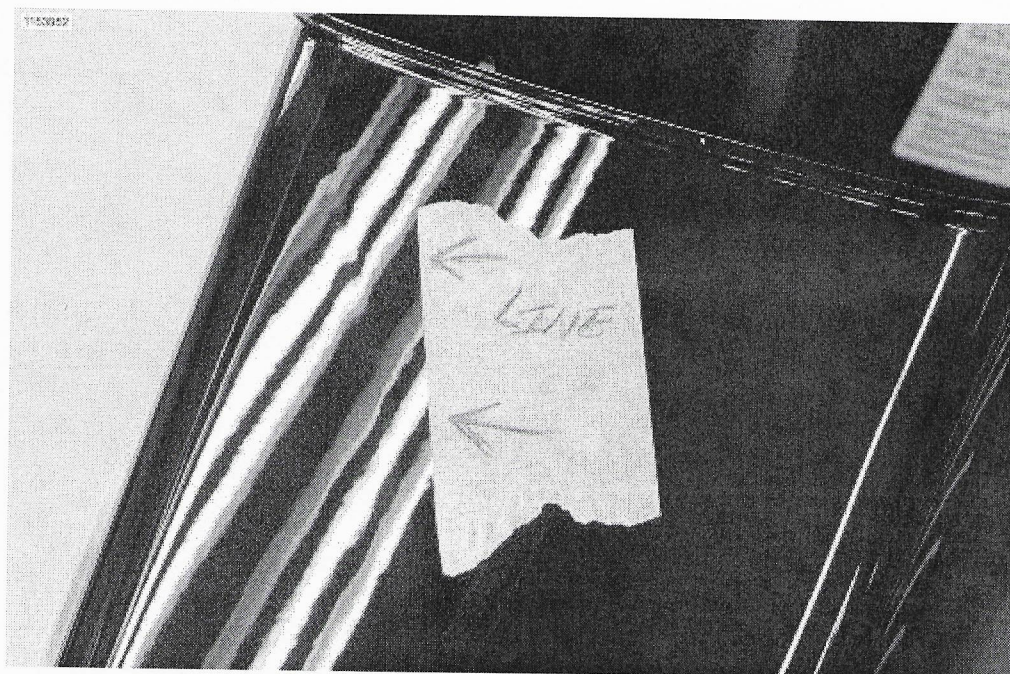


The part is warrantable if:

- The concern/imperfection exceeds 0.762 mm (0.030 in) and is not repairable. (See Tech Tip 397.)
- Damage such as: scratches, scuffs, chips, cracks, and dents is not repairable, and identified, verified and recorded per the Market Specific Warranty Manual. (Pre Delivery Inspection Claims Only - PRD Type)
- Paint or clear coat is flaking, peeling, blistered or bubbled. (Excludes environmental damage.)
- Paint is light or incorrect shade. (Some shade difference is allowed due to the manufacturing process.)
- Welds are inconsistent in appearance.

Typical non-warrantable conditions:

- Swirl marks and fine scratches that are repairable by buffing.
- Orange Peel is present at a consistent level.
- Damage is such that it can be repaired.
- Denim paint replacement parts color or tone is slightly off due to aging.
- Knit lines are present on the rear facing side of saddlebags. See Figure 1.
- Mold lines on Trike trunk doors.
- Shock lines in sheet metal parts.
- Plastic substrate cracks.
